MINUTES OF MEETING

The Minutes of Meeting dated Wednesday 13th July 2022 were agreed and signed as a true record.
The Planning minutes of meeting dated 2nd August 2022 were agreed and signed.

FLY TIPPING PRESENTATION

The Chairman welcomed Andy and Rachel to the meeting. Andy stated there is an issue with fly-tipping especially in Locality 5 and during 2021 there were 1,285 fly tipping incidents which South Staffs Council had to clear up. It was stated that fly tipping needs to be reported as soon as possible. Rachel reported on case studies and stated householders need to ensure disposal of their waste is carried out by an authorised waste transfer business and make sure they have the necessary paperwork to confirm waste has been disposed of correctly.

Signs are available for locations where tipping occurs regularly and Parishes are being encouraged to put up these signs. South Staffs Council are able to apply to the Courts to place cameras in hot spots. The Chairman thanked Andy and Rachel for their presentation and requested signs for this Parish. Cllr. Kelly reported fly tipping of uPVC window frame on drive of property on Bell Road, Trysull.
