**PROPOSED QUARRY AT SHIPLEY**

The Chairman stated this mid month meeting has been called to discuss the proposed quarry at Shipley and whether the Parish Council will make any comment to Shropshire Council.

**PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Mr. Andrew Haden spoke on behalf of the visitors and informed the Parish Council of their objections to the proposed quarry at Shipley. Strong concerns regarding the large number of lorries which will be using Bridgnorth Road, damage to highways, wildlife and dust problems were expressed by Mr. Haden and other visitors.

Mr. Haden enquired about dust at Seisdon quarry and it was stated there have been problems with dust over the past years and Councillors were willing to confirm this in writing.

Each Councillor made comments regarding the proposed quarry and it was reported there may be further sites in Seisdon where sand could be quarried. It was stated the Parish Council has a responsibility to its residents and must act in their best interests. The Parish Council do not wish to have lorries travelling through Trysull & Seisdon from the proposed Shipley quarry and a weight restriction order on Fox Road and Ebstree Road, Seisdon, has been requested.

It was pointed out that the Parish Council are not consultees and will not be asked for comments.

It was **resolved** the Parish Council would not oppose the proposed quarry at Shipley.

There was nothing further to discuss and the Chairman thanked the public for attending.
