### **NEW HIGHWAY MATTERS**

Pot holes: Langley Road near to junction with Radford Lane and also before Dimingsdale bridge opposite the bus shelter. Clerk to inform Highways Hotline.  
Hedge by the Ovens End bridge needs to be cut back to aid visibility. Clerk to write to landowner.

### **ANY NEW BUSINESS**

The Clerk was asked to inform Planning Enforcement about unauthorised residential use. Copy to Cllr. McCardle.

### **PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

Two mirrors on Ebstree Road obscuring visibility to the right when exiting Trysull Holloway. Clerk to inform Highways Hotline.

A drone is being flown every weekend from a field in Seisdon Road. Clerk to notify the relevant authorities.

Weeds growing through footpath which runs between Fox Close and the yew tree making it difficult to walk along. Clerk to inform Highways Hotline.

It was reported that the Fox Road/Bridgnorth Road junction and the Smestow/Feiashill Road junction are dangerous and it was felt traffic lights would slow the traffic and make it safer. Cllr. Wilson will discuss traffic lights at the Fox Road junction with Mark Keeling.

It was reported the grass in front of the apartments on the corner of Fox Road and Tinkers Castle Road is very untidy and the Clerk was asked to write to Mr. Martin Cox to ascertain whether he owns this land and whether he would arrange for it to be cut short.

### **MATTERS ARISING**

#### Play Area

Cllr. Neil Compson has met Mr. Gary Parker, Sutcliffe Play, on site to discuss work which still needs to be carried out.

#### Playing Fields

Cllr. R.J. McCardle has been re-appointed to serve as the representative on the Trysull & Seisdon Playing Fields Committee.

The Clerk reported that quotations will need to be sought for the 2018 grass cutting season.

#### 1350 Footpaths

Bridlepath 15 - 'No turning' sign has been referred to the local community programme.

Mr. Steve Birch, JPE, has stated he will tidy up the part of the path which is in his ownership.

Footpath sign is in position but is rotten at the bottom. Cllr. Kelly will speak to Mr. Rochfort about supplying signs and the Parish Council arranging for these to be erected.

#### Footpath 17

This route remains closed until November 2017 or until the works to repair the path have been completed.

Reply received stating Woodford Lane has been inspected and potholes have been identified. It was reported this lane is in a very bad state and the Clerk to ask when this work is to be carried out.

Simon Griffiths, SCC. has written to the Landowner and this has been re-issued because they have not received a reply.

Woodford Road, Trysull (Enquiry 40446 25) Pot holes reported. Site has been assessed.

Union Lane - blocked gully outside Awbridge Cottage reported to Highways Hotline.

Wombourne Road (Enquiry 4060863) Trees and hedges overhanging Wombourne Road from Bratch Farm to Union Lane need to be cut back to prevent damage to vehicles and assist visibility.

Overgrown hedge, Trysull Holloway (Enquiry 4060859)

Post Office Road (Enquiry 4064667) Two large potholes outside Nurseries. Site assessed.

Fox Road (Enquiry 4062441) Damage to highway verges.

Ebstree Road (Enquiry 4064671) Deep ruts in carriageway from Trysull Holloway to Seisdon Quarry.

Hedge, Feiashill Road - Cllr. Compson will visit and ask for overgrown hedge to be cut back.
